Procedure for Club membership

1. Submit a completed application for membership form.
2. Proof of background check with a copy of one of the following:
 - a. A copy of your current Washington State concealed carry permit.
 - b. A copy of a NICS background check paid for by applicant.
 - c. Current law enforcement identification.
 - d. Current member of WAC.
 - e. A recent receipt of purchase of firearm, with name of purchaser on receipt.
3. A copy of your photo id.
4. Bring all completed paper work, copies and dues to a club meeting where your membership will be confirmed. Meetings are held on the third Tuesday of the month at 7:00 PM at the range. If you are unable to attend a Tuesday meeting other arrangement can be made. Please contact the secretary at penriflepistolclub@olympen.com to make other arrangements.
5. You, will be required to attend and pass Range Safety Officer and Orientation class. This required class is given approximately every three months and is about 4 to 5 hours. This class covers:
 - a. Range Safety Office training
 - b. Range Orientation
 - c. General Range and Safety Rules
 - d. Proficiency test, which will demonstrate the safe use and handling of a firearm when loading, firing, unloading a firearm. A slow fire (5 rounds) and a timed fire (5 rounds in 30 seconds) at 50 feet, or 25 feet for smaller firearms. All 10 rounds must impact the defined target area.

If you have a Family Membership all members must take the RSOO class, Children ages 10 and up that will be shooting at the Range will need to be present at the class but do not need to qualify in shooting.

note: You must successfully pass both of these requirements before you can have individual access to shoot at the range.
